

JOB SUMMARY: Slickline Helper

Under moderate supervision, performs such duties as required in the servicing of oil and gas wells and the maintenance and repair of service units and tools. The Helper will broaden experience on well sites and primary tool maintenance.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

1. Operates, under normal conditions, the winch unit for running in and out of the hole; "zeros" tools and monitors tension meter, Line speed, depth and spooling of cable/slickline; understands depth control and weight indicator systems; uses all winch cable safety controls.
2. Prepares well for service operations, aligns slickline unit and crane, installs sheave wheel, Rope sockets, and connects multiple tools as required.
3. Learns to select, load and unload required tools and corresponding surface instrumentation for the job.
4. Learns to assist the Engineer/Field technician in maintenance checks of tools and equipment in the Cell.
5. Participates in inspecting, maintaining and repairing primary tools, service units, and associated equipment according to Standard operating procedure
6. Learns to service, maintain, and assist in Slickline and braided line maintenance
7. Learns to build rope sockets for Slickline and Braided line
8. Identifies the surface and down hole, tools, and associated equipment required to run each service in the district.
9. Observes safe-working practices, rules and regulations, wears safety equipment as required, and corrects and reports hazards immediately.
10. Works well with other employees to ensure the smooth operation of the district.
11. Maintains tools, shop, and equipment in good condition and keeps shop and work area in a clean and orderly condition.
12. Drives transport units and slickline trucks safely.

MARGINAL FUNCTIONS:

1. Performs other duties as assigned by direct supervisor.
2. Attends and participates in safety meetings as required.
3. Keeps and maintains time sheets, DOT logs, and dangerous goods forms current and accurate.
4. Keeps up to date on >90% of NEST requirements.
5. Performs tool TRIM.
6. Calibrates and redress tools as required.

JOB SPECIFICATIONS:**Education:**

1. High school education or equivalent.
2. Commercial driver's license; maintenance of DOT and Company driving standards.

Experience:

1. Minimum of six months as a Trainee Helper.
2. Experience in accurately meeting predetermined specifications.

Physical Requirements:
